Residential Disabled Parking Zone Policy

The following policy concerns the installation of disabled parking signs at a residential property:

1. The applicant must have a valid disability permit or plate from the State.
2. The applicant must show that he/she does not have any accessible space available on the residential property and that parking availability near the residence is limited.
3. If the application is filled out by a tenant, the consent of the property owner will be required.
4. The space requested shall be in front of the applicant's residence and there shall not be any conflict with traffic lanes or safety zones. All other street regulations will apply.
5. The space identified on-street will not be for the exclusive use of the applicant/resident but for any user with a valid permit or plate. The space may be used as a pick-up/drop off zone by authorized vehicles for applicant.
6. The applicant shall pay \$125.00 towards the cost of the sign, its installation, maintenance and removal.
7. No other accommodations (including but not limited to: curb painting, curb cuts, or sidewalk accessibility) shall be required to be made by the city at the time of the granting of the application or in the future.
8. The application is subject to the approval of both the Public Works Director and Chief of Police. Any appeal/denial should be heard by the Public Works Committee.
9. All approved signs and appurtances are to be installed by the city.

DISABILITY PARKING SPACES: Disability Parking Signs are installed at the request of property OWNERS or others, in front of their property. IF they, or their relative living with them, or their renter, have current Disability Plates or a Disability Certificate (Hanging Tag). The Disability Parking space is not exclusively for use by the property owner. Anyone having a vehicle with Disability License Plates or displaying a Disability Certificate (Hanging Tag) may park in the signed place.




Location Options for Disability Zone
