When you complete and submit the Citizen Camera Systems Program enrollment form, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- If necessary, the Wahpeton Police Department will contact you directly, using the information provided by you at the time of registration to request appropriate video surveillance footage.
- Any and all video surveillance footage shall remain the property of the registrant until it is request by the Wahpeton Police Department and collected from the registrant by the Wahpeton Police Department.
- Your voluntary participation in this program shall not be construed as an obligation to release any surveillance video to the Wahpeton Police Department upon request.
- Any video surveillance footage containing or related to criminal activity collected by the Wahpeton Police Department may be used as evidence during any stage of a criminal proceeding.
- Under no circumstances, shall registrants construe that they are acting as an agent of and/or employee of the City of Wahpeton and/or the Wahpeton Police Department through this program.
- Under no circumstances shall the Wahpeton Police Department utilize any information obtained to view footage/feeds directly from cameras owned by registrants.
- Registrants may request to be removed from the program at any time by again utilizing the enrollment form and checking the box to “Remove your cameras from the Wahpeton Police Department records”.
- Registrants understand the name and address information will be collected as a part of the program and this information is considered to be a public record under the North Dakota Open Records Law. The City of Wahpeton and Wahpeton Police Department will only disclose this information upon proper request under these terms.
