Mayor Hansey called the meeting to order at 12:56 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS - Yard Waste Disposal Services

DeVries explained that the Public Works Committee is recommending that the City Council approve option 7: Discontinuing the yard waste disposal service. The inert landfill is no longer able to collect yard waste to include grass clippings and leaves so Waste Management contacted the city with other options for this service. Several of the options would require additional rate increases for the service. Options for residents who wish to use this service is:

- 1) They can call Waste Management to up-size their trash container. An upgrade fee will apply to the customer. A second container can be requested at a reduced cost.
- 2) They can haul yard waste to Waste Management's transfer station for a charge per disposal.

Motion by Devries, seconded by Wateland, to choose Option 7 to discontinue the yard waste disposal service. On roll call vote, DeVries, Bertsch, Lambrecht, Wateland, Dale, Bajumpaa, and Schmidt voted in favor. Motion carried.

Motion by Lambrecht, seconded by Bajumpaa and carried, to adjourn at 12:58 p.m.
